#### New and enhanced features

#### **Enhancement in assessment on Portal**

The states may want to enable the user to take assessments using question set players with attempt count capability. The question set players UI has rich text, text alignment and image formatting, offline playing of questions, and support for MCQ layouts

#### Enhanced search on the mobile app

The search option on the homepage is equipped with discovering content according to both primary and secondary categories. Users can search with additional categories such as **TV lessons**.

#### **Ability to view content details**

Providing additional information about the available content on the mobile app helps the user in determining whether to consume the content. The information is standardised across the content in different categories.

# **Discovery of promoted content or initiatives**

State's are in need of spotlighting the featured content and some active programs for the users. This capability is achieved with the introduction of banners on mobile app and portal. On tapping that banner, users get access to all content being promoted as part of that initiative.

#### **Enhancements to dashlets**

Dashlets, a module that allows contextual reports inside a workflow, are reporting widgets embedding in any contextual workflow. To run targeted programs, States need contextual data-driven reports for consumption, creation or administration.

To further enhance this solution from the previous release, the DIKSHA's dashlets capability will show data in tables, big numbers as a format and download chart data as a CSV.

# **Enabling debug mode on Desktop app/Portal (client-side)**

In the previous release, troubleshooting the DIKSHA mobile app using a "debug mode" was enabled. For the self-sustainability of individual users, the Desktop app and portal are also equipped with the feature to allow users to turn ON/OFF the debug mode. Keeping the debug mode ON enables users to share more data with the State. The State can also choose to get it accomplished from the backend.

# Notifications for better user experience

Admins & members are notified of important actions for effective management (e.g. when a member leaves a group or when someone responds or upvotes a topic created by a member in discussions etc.)

#### **Enhance user interface for different features**

Button names, tab names, tooltips are changed in tabs and features such as Home, Explore, Course, Digital Textbook, Discussion forums for a better user experience. Also, the appropriate error codes and messages will be displayed to the user when they encounter issues during usage.

Often, users don't have a network or work in an area with no internet. Hence, accessing observations with and without rubric offline is provided that enables users to work independently from network availability.
