New and enhanced features

Non-editable mandatory tasks

The users can not make any changes to a mandatory task. The users will have to complete a mandatory task without making any changes in description or timelines to be able to complete the project.

Displaying Start and End Date of Conversation

The WhatsApp chatbot creator can now define the start and end date of any conversation on chatbot interface.
